

**MEMORANDUM
ON COOPERATION BETWEEN
TASHKENT STATE UNIVERSITY OF LAW (UZBEKISTAN)
AND
EAST CHINA UNIVERSITY OF POLITICAL SCIENCE AND LAW
(PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA)**

With the purpose to establish the friendly relations and understanding between the two universities, and further development of mutually beneficial cooperation in the spheres of higher education and research, the Tashkent state university of Law and East China University of Political Science and Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties") concluded the present Memorandum as the following:

Article 1

The main objectives of this Memorandum is to unite efforts of two universities for mutual development of various educational projects, implementation of academic exchange of students, teaching staff, exchange of academic information and research data between universities, including electronic legal resources.

The parties understand and agree that this Memorandum is the basis for the development of specific programs of cooperation between the two universities, which will be specified in the separate Agreements with exchange conditions and details of the interactions.

List of forms of cooperation specified in this Memorandum will not be an obstacle to the development of new forms of cooperation, subject to appropriate rules for their development are followed and the project proposal is approved by the parties.

Article 2

Parties agreed to make efforts to enhance the experience in the management structures of the universities, the exchange of information on academic issues, efficient teaching methods, including distance learning.

With the purpose to implement this Memorandum, the parties agreed that the term "student" means a full-time student studying at bachelors at the university, the student studying at masters program and a doctoral student.

Article 3

The parties expressed their desire to share the textbooks, manuals, publications and other materials which demonstrate achievements of two universities and also an electronic legal resources.

Article 4

The parties expressed the desire to conduct joint scientific researches on the most pressing problems of legal education and science, as well as researches in the sphere of the management of educational process.

The parties will have the equal rights to use the results of their joint work within the framework of inter-university cooperation.

Article 5

The Parties will cooperate in the sphere of foreign language training along with legal education.

Article 6

Both of the parties will develop exchange programs for students, teaching staff, researchers and administrative and management staff on the terms set forth in the Agreements.

Article 7

The parties agreed to invite teachers, researchers and administrative and managerial personnel to participate in scientific conferences and symposiums.

Article 8

The Parties shall cooperate in the development of masters and doctoral programs, as well as a distance learning programs and joint programs of professional retraining.

Article 9

This Memorandum may be amended and supplemented by mutual consent of the Parties through written protocols between them which constitute an integral part of this Memorandum and shall become effective in an order provided for the present Memorandum.

Article 10

This Memorandum will come into force upon its signing by both of the parties and shall be valid for 5 years. If within 6 months prior to the date of expiry of the Memorandum, neither party will raise in written form a desire to terminate

this Memorandum or to change its terms and conditions, this Memorandum shall be deemed automatically extended for the next 5 years.
